1	Luna/Hiro can have several seizures during the day. Professionals and adults working with Luna/Hiro should understand these symptoms as a communication of distress.	3	2	6	Treat	It can be unhelpful to try to 'catch out' a young person with these symptoms as it can build distrust and ultimately cause more distress, adding to the symptom cycle. Luna/Hiro does not need any medication. Offering unnecessary medication may in fact cause harm.	2	All staff	02/03/21
2	Luna/Hiro has experienced physical symptoms including seizure-like events where he will often drop to the floor and begin shaking and twisting her limbs and reduced mobility (e.g. leg weakness.) This can lead to him fainting or falling on the floor and hurting himself or somebody else.	2	3	6	Treat	If Luna/Hiro is able to state that symptoms are about to occur, he should be allowed to remove herself from the environment for symptoms to resolve, then return to the activity. Staff should notice when functional symptoms are occurring as early as possible to prevent escalation. These commonly occur at high levels of distress. Luna/Hiro does not need any medication. Luna/Hiro does not need to go to hospital unless he inadvertently harms himself during the episode or the symptom is new/different. State "Hiro, I am going to leave you alone now", he should not be touched or restrained. He should return to normal activities as soon as possible. Staff should be aware he may be more fatigued. If Luna/Hiro loses mobility he should be allowed to sit comfortably. Urgent psychiatry assessment is unlikely to be required	3	All staff	02/03/21
