After 5 minutes staff should engage in light conversation with Matthew and try to redirect on to a fun activity or topic 3. Matthew will either come back inside at this point or he will abscond, in case of absconding follow protocol below.	1	All staff	13/10/20
2	If Matthew abscondes while out in the community this presents a greater threat. Matthew may try to run away from staff. When in a heightened state Matthew does not have full awareness of road safety and may injur themselves	1	3	3	Treat	1. Staff should follow Matthew at a safe distance and ensure that he is safe from roads and other members of the public. Should he come close to a road staff should stop him from crossing. 2. If staff feel that is safe to do so they should attempt to catch and speak to Matthew to calm him down. 3.
